

**SOUTH CENTRAL INDIANA RURAL ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION**

**RESIDENTIAL DEMAND REDUCTION RATE  
RATE SCHEDULE – RS-DR  
EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2010**

**Availability**

Available as an optional rate to any residential or farm consumer of the Corporation for single-phase electric service at a single delivery point who has installed an automatic standby generator. The generator must be at least 15 KW capacity. A representative of the Corporation must certify the standby generator has adequate capacity to supply the home during Corporation initiated control periods. A Demand Response Unit (DRU) must be installed that allows for remote control of the standby generator during peak periods as determined by the Corporation. The rated capacity of any motor served under this schedule in excess of ten (10) horsepower shall be subject to the approval of the Corporation. A consumer choosing this optional rate must remain on the rate for a minimum of six months. Consumers opting to change to a different rate schedule after the six month minimum period must wait a minimum of six months before returning to this optional rate.

**Type of Service**

Single-phase sixty (60) cycles at 120/240 secondary voltage.

**Monthly Rate**

**Hoosier Energy Adjustment**

The above rates may be subject from time to time to a purchased power cost adjustment tracking factor as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. The purchased power cost adjustment tracking factor applicable hereto is shown in Appendix A.

**Minimum Monthly Billing**

The minimum monthly billing under the above rate shall be \$33.04.

**Terms of Payment**

The above rate is net, the gross rate being 5% higher on the current net monthly bill. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within seventeen (17) days of the bill date, the gross rate shall apply. When the seventeenth day falls on Sunday or any other legal holiday, the first business day thereafter shall be added to the seventeen-day period. If a delinquent balance exists, all payments will be first applied to such delinquent balance.

### **Conditions of Service**

Standby generator and load transfer switch and all wiring, poles, lines, and other electrical equipment beyond the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer. All devices and equipment deemed necessary by the Corporation to remotely operate the standby generator will be installed and maintained by the Corporation and will remain the property of the Corporation. Corporation personnel shall be permitted to have access to all devices and equipment and all times.

### **Remote Control of Generator**

The Corporation may remotely operate the standby generator during periods of time (control periods) determined by the Corporation in its sole discretion. The control periods shall be limited to the winter months of December, January and February and the summer months of June, July, and August. The Corporation is not required to give notice prior to remotely operating the standby generator during the control periods. At no time however, will the Corporation remotely operate the standby generator for more than eight (8) hours in a 24-hour period or for more than one hundred fifty (120) hours in any calendar year.

### **Fuel Reimbursement**

In March of each year the Corporation will pay a fuel reimbursement to the member. The fuel reimbursement shall be based on \$3.75 per hour for each hour in excess of eighty (80) hours the Corporation controlled the member's standby generator during the previous twelve (12) month period of March through February.

### **Hold Harmless**

Consumer agrees the Corporation will not be held liable for an loss or damage sustained by the consumer, or any other person or entity, due to remote control of the standby generator. Consumer assumes all responsibility for any loss or damage or claim associated with the interruption or reconnection of service and to save and hold harmless the Corporation for any claim of loss or damage by the Consumer or any other person due to an interruption or reconnection of service.

### **Miscellaneous Nonrecurring Charges**

Consumers served under this rate schedule shall be subject to the miscellaneous nonrecurring charges as stated in Appendix C, which may be charged to the consumer as applicable.

### **Operation Roundup®**

Consumers served under this rate schedule may voluntarily participate in the Operation Roundup® program as described in Appendix D.

### **Interpretation of Schedule**

The interpretation of or the application by the Corporation or by any consumer of all rates, rules, and regulations included in this rate schedule shall be subject to review by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, consistent with its service rules and regulations or policies, except as otherwise provided by law.

**Rate Schedule Modifications**

All rate schedules and charges, as well as the Corporation's service rules and regulations or policies, may be amended or modified, in whole or in part, at any time as deemed appropriate by the Corporation's Board of Directors.
